November in Escondido: News about events in our larger community:

The Reed Reservoir Replacement Project: The Geotechnical Engineers from Ninyo and Moore of San Diego visited the site on 9/29/10 to observe the exposed sub-grade. The grade for the tank on the north side was inspected and found to comply with the design requirements. The excavation continues for the southernmost tank. Two stubborn veins of very hard rock have been encountered causing the grading contractor to use hydraulic rock breaking equipment.



Pipelines that will be used to fill and empty the tanks will be installed underneath the tank floors. This again may cause some difficult trenching under small parts of the tanks and some additional rock breaking. The next steps will include the placement and compaction of crushed aggregate base materials to support the tank floors. You may be relieved to know that we will not be setting up a rock crushing plant at the jobsite, but this means that the special base materials will be trucked in. Before too long the carpenters will be setting forms and the concrete work for the tank floors will be started.
