Reed Reservoir Replacement Project Update, July 2011: Wrapping of the north tank was completed and the DYK machine was dismantled and moved off site. The color coat was applied to the north tank. Valves and piping in the valve vault were painted. The 24-inch overflow line was installed as was the 30-inch outlet pipe. As of the end of the month, crews were working on other inlet/outlet piping and all pipes had been pre-soaked and hydrostatic-tested.

From Android devices go to the Android marketplace and search for Escondido Report It. You can also input Android Marketplace <https://market.android.com/details?id=com.citysourced.escondidoca> directly into your address bar on the phone (not on the desktop).

Blackberry Users

From Touch Screen devices type:

From non Touch Screen devices type:
