

Our HOA Needs YOUR Help!!!

Trails

The Hidden Trails neighborhood is framed by an attractive multi-use trail. This trail begins at the entrance to our community on Hidden Trails Rd., and terminates at the Reed Reservoir.

This trail is comprised of Decomposed Granite (D.G.) held in place with wooden edge restraints, with the occasional railroad tie to help divert water. During the rainy season, you have likely noticed an erosion problem with this DG.

The board has contracted with a company to solve this problem.



Repair

Stabilizer bonds the aggregate material together, so wind and rain do not erode the trail.

During the repair, you will see employees from California Earthcare performing the following:

1. grading, contouring and compacting the soil to final elevations
2. tilling soil to the specified depth of treatment with a roto-tiller
3. spraying-applying the stabilizer onto the loose soil
4. tilling the soil again to thoroughly mix soil and stabilizer
5. re-compacting the soil with a steel drum roller
6. spraying-applying stabilizer onto the compact soil surface



The soil will then need time to thoroughly dry.

YOUR Help

Before this work can commence, we need to ensure the soil is in the proper condition. You can help by monitoring your irrigation system, and disabling any heads that dampen the path.

Please help us keep this trail dry during the work period beginning **January 21st, 2008**.
